**MOTION TO INTERVENE; OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND; NOTICE OF
HEARING; AND ORDER THEREON**

On May 27, 2025, Applicant State Farm General Insurance Company
(Applicant, State Farm, or SFG) filed a document titled "Response to Merritt David
Farren's Petition to Participate and Notice of Intent to Seek Compensation,"
including Attachment 1 (Opposition).³

Attachment 1 to the Opposition consists of an electronic mail exchange between Applicant's counsel and Merritt David Farren, along with a copy of "Merritt David Farren's Petition to Participate and Notice of Intent to Seek Compensation" (Motion). The Motion appears to have been directed to the Applicant and served on the Rate Enforcement Bureau of the California Department of Insurance (CDI or Department) and the Public Advisor of the California Department of Insurance.

The Motion is deemed filed as of today and will be treated and characterized as a Motion to Intervene.⁴ SFG's Opposition is also acknowledged as a timely response.⁵

Other parties to this case may now exercise their right to file and serve a written response to the Motion no later than Monday, June 9, 2025.⁶ Notwithstanding, to ensure expediency, non-moving parties are encouraged to submit their responses as soon as possible. If a party chooses not to file a substantive response, they should promptly submit a notice indicating their decision to decline.

Movant Merritt David Farren (Farren) may elect to file and serve a written reply to State Farm's Opposition no later than Monday, June 9, 2025.⁷ Farren may also file and serve a written reply to any other party's response within three days of its filing and service date.⁸ Notwithstanding, to ensure expediency, Farren is encouraged to submit any reply as soon as possible.⁹

⁸ A reply to a response filed and served on June 5, 2025, is due no later than June 9, 2025; on June 6, 2025, no later than June 9, 2025; and on June 9, 2025, no later than June 12, 2025.

All papers and pleadings shall be filed with the Administrative Hearing Bureau.¹⁰ The use of electronic mail directed to AHB's legal secretarial staff, Florinda Cristobal (415-538-4172, florinda.cristobal@insurance.ca.gov) and Camille Johnson (415-538-4243, camille.johnson@insurance.ca.gov) is confirmed for this purpose.

Administrative Law Judge Karl Fredric J. Seligman will hear the Motion,¹¹ in-person, at a **reported** hearing on a law and motion calendar commencing at **11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 11, 2025**, at AHB's Los Angeles courtroom,¹² located at on the 1st Floor, in the Lobby level of the North Tower, at the Ronald Reagan State Building, located at 300 South Spring Street, in Los Angeles, California.¹³ An attorney is required to appear for any party that is, or becomes, represented.¹⁴

¹¹ In their respective briefing or at oral argument, the parties are invited to address whether the ALJ has the authority to exercise the Commissioner's powers in connection with the movant's compensation eligibility request. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 10, §§ 2654.1, subd. (c), 2662.2.) If such authority exists, they should also discuss whether the exercise of discretion would be appropriate under the circumstances in this case.

¹³ When in-person participation is expected, it signifies that attendance is required to be heard on the matter, unless a necessary accommodation is requested. Neither a hybrid nor remote format will be considered solely for convenience or cost-saving purposes, except in cases where access to justice would otherwise be hindered. Nonetheless, the Department inquired with AHB about remote participation for purposes of this Motion. Given the shortened timing of notice of the hearing on the Motion, the legal secretarial staff was directed to communicate that CDI may participate by teleconference. However, if circumstances change to allow counsel's in-person attendance for the Department, it is encouraged, particularly considering the potential scheduling implications from the outcome of the pending Motion.
