**ORDER RESERVING CERTAIN
MOTIONS FOR SPECIAL SETTING**

Upon review prompted by the informal inquiry from Counsel for State Farm General Insurance Company regarding the hearing format for Friday, October 17, 2025, the Administrative Hearing Bureau realizes that Intervenor Merritt David Farren's availability was not confirmed prior to finalizing the calendar set forth in the Amended Scheduling Order dated October 9, 2025, and filed on October 10, 2025 (Scheduling Order).¹ The Administrative Law Judge will not require the parties to assemble where the movant is unavailable to appear in person on his own motions.²

Given the travel obligations of some participants, including the Administrative Law Judge, and the lack of confirmed availability from the movant, the ALJ finds it imprudent to proceed with the



schedule as contemplated.³ Accordingly, the calendaring set for October 16 and 17, 2025, under the Scheduling Order is hereby suspended and subject to special setting.⁴
