On October 3, 2025, the Insurance Commissioner issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, proposing to amending California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Chapter 5, Subchapter 4.8, Article 6, Section 2646.2 and Subchapter 4.9, Article 3, Section 2651.1; Article 4, Sections 2652.8 and 2652.9; Article 5, Sections 2653.1, 2653.4, and 2653.5; Article 8, Sections 2656.1, 2656.2, 2656.3, 2656.4; Article 13, Sections 2661.1, 2661.3, 2661.4; and Article 14, Sections 2662.1, 2662.2, 2662.3, 2662.5, 2662.6, 2662.7; adopting Subchapter 4.9, Article 6, Section 2654.3 and Article 13, Section 2661.5; and repealing Subchapter 4.9, Article 14, Section 2662.4 of the title and chapter referenced above.
